You have an opportunity to make a difference!

We seek volunteer lawyers to conduct public information sessions on good credit practices, in Washington, D.C, during Pro Bono Week 2009. The sessions will offer basic legal and practical information on consumer credit and borrowing. A background or legal experience in consumer credit is not needed to volunteer. Legal advice about individual situations will not be provided at the sessions.

Here is how it works:

Organizations and groups request an information session at a place and time convenient for the organization or group. The demographics of the groups will vary from students in high school to senior citizens.

What you need to do:

1. Register for a short consumer practices training session.* Currently three trainings are scheduled to be held at convenient locations in the city. During the training, you will be provided with all of the information and materials needed to conduct a session.
2. Register to present at one of the sessions. Each session is expected to last about one hour and will be led by two volunteer lawyers. The sessions will be very structured, and you will be provided with all of the information you need during your training.
