

RESOLUTION OF HALE COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, the Plainview office of Legal Aid of NorthWest Texas assists in the delivery of legal services to low-income persons through its conduct of a private attorney placement program and its rendition of legal services by pro bono attorneys; and

WHEREAS, there are only a limited number of legal aid lawyers and a large number of low-income residents in LANWT'S Plainview office service area who are unable to obtain civil legal services; and

WHEREAS, it appears that low income persons in the area served by the Plainview office of LANWT would benefit from the legal community's continuation of free legal services; and

WHEREAS, the participating attorneys in pro bono activities are significantly expanding the availability of legal services for the poor; and

WHEREAS, the American Bar Association Code of Professional Responsibility and the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct have long recognized the need for lawyers to be mindful of the deficiencies in the administration of justice and to devote professional time to representation of poor, disadvantaged and low-income individuals;
