Advocacy is an exercise in persuasion. The successful advocate not only focuses the fact finder on the important issues in a case, but does so in a way that motivates the decision maker to reach a favorable result. Knowledge of the facts and the law is the foundation for effective advocacy, but true persuasion relies upon a variety of subtle elements, working in combination, which inspire confidence that the advocate is right.

Powerful advocacy is more than a matter of style. It includes the ability to inspire, but also the ability to communicate in a way that cuts to the heart of a case with such clarity and logic that the result urged by the advocate seems not only correct, but inevitable.

This course will focus on how to harness the power of ideas - the means by which attorneys can conceptualize and present arguments in the most effective way, to rise above mere presentation of a case and engage in the art of advocacy.
