In her previous leadership roles at what is now the Washington Lawyers' Committee for Civil Rights and Urban Affairs, Ms. Buchanan litigated civil rights cases that have led to important and long-lasting reforms in public policy.

A 1985 graduate of LSIC's criminal division, Mr. Salzman has spent more than 30 years working on behalf of poor and indigent, justice-involved people.
